right fit on every level, the A.D. said.

“I have 15 sets of eyes looking at me, wondering, ‘Who’s going to be our coach?’” Herbster said. “I don’t want to let them down. And I certainly don’t want to let their parents down.”

“It’s about finding someone who can shape those people.”
