Book On Rural Cemeteries Published

Coinciding with the recognition in Yankton and in South Dakota of the state's 125th birthday, local author Maxine Schuurmans Kinsley has compiled and published an illustrated historical directory identifying and locating Yankton County's pioneer churches and cemeteries, "Pioneer Churches and Cemeteries in Yankton County, South Dakota: An Illustrated Historical Directory.'

Her research provides an ethnic footprint of the immigration sweep from east to west encouraged by the Homestead Act of 1862, which allowed "free" land for immigrants and Easterners alike.

With camera in hand, Kinsley toured the county to "gather, organize and record" content (her mantra) for the 66page publication, beginning in Part One with the spread of pioneer church denominations from Yankton Village to all of Yankton County before and after villages appeared. Part Two identifies and locates more than 50 pioneer cemeteries, including five located in or adjoining Yankton itself, and public and private family burial grounds located in the county.

pastors began visiting primitive Yankton Village on the Missouri River soon after it was founded in 1859. In 1861, Pastor Melancthon Hoyt held the first Episcopal service in Yankton in his new St. John's Episcopal Church. By that time, Rev. Septimus W. Ingham had already laid roots for the Methodist Episcopal Church, and later in the decade, Joseph and Sarah Ward were instrumental in establishing the Congregational Church. All three denominations would endure, as would Sacred Heart Catholic Church, founded in 1871 by Fr. Valentine Sommereisen by order of the Bishop of St. Paul. Other denominations including Evangelical and Baptist, functioned as well.

The largest ethnic group to settle in rural Yankton County was made up of Norwegian and Scandinavian Lutherans who settled mainly in north and east townships. By 1869, newcomers had already built their first Norwegian church. Rural Vangen Lutheran Church, which still stands, will observe its 150th anniversary this summer. A cluster of Bohemians settled in southwestern Yankton County in 1869 and that year built tiny St. John the

Baptist Catholic Church, first in the county. The restored church stands today in Tabor's Czech Heritage Park. In the mid-1870s Germans, mainly from Russia, established three rural German Reformed Churches and three German Lutheran Churches in central and northwestern Yankton County. Only Martinus Lutheran Church functions today. Two Catholic churches, one with German roots and the other with Irish roots, remain where once were six, including a Polish parish in Ziskov Township. One rural Norwegian Baptist Church and one German Evangelical Church also succumbed to changing times. Rural cemeteries mark all known church locations. Community and family burial grounds, including abandoned cemeteries, are noted as well.

"Pioneer Churches and Cemeteries in Yankton County, South Dakota: An Illustrated Historical Directory" provides a detailed but concise overview of a period in local history that has often been overlooked. Interested persons may contact the author for more information at 605-664-2015.
