The Bible reveals to us that there are only few that find the way which leadeth

Most people are looking for ways to please God that they may obtain forgiveness of sins, when there is only one way. The Word of God reveals to us that Jesus Christ is the only way to Heaven.

John 14:6: Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth and the life: no man

for by the law is the knowledge of sin. But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe, for there is no difference, for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.

Being justified (declared righteous) freely (without the works of the law) by His grace through the redemption that is in Jesus Christ.

Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation (God is satisfied with the blood sacrifice made for sins) through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past; through the forbearance of of God; to declare, I say, at this time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of Him which believe in Jesus.

Our faith must be in Jesus Christ alone, the straight gate, the narrow way or there is not salvation.

If any man on earth was good enough, then he would not need the righteousness of God that is put on our accountm when we trust by faith that Jesus is Lord and

Hebrews 1:3 reveals to us in the word of God that Jesus "by himself purged our sins and sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.'

Jesus did what no man can do, which is shed his blood to appease the wrath of God and cleanse a sinner, as well as presenting it before the Father in Heaven, going into the Holy Place and sprinkling his blood on the mercy seat where it still

After three days and three nights, Jesus bodily rose from the grave, giving to all believers in him, them looking forward to a resurrected body.
