# Lancers Split With BC Mingo, SDSU Golfers On A Roll

The Mount Marty College softball team did not bring the warm weather back with them from Arizona, but the Lancers found their hot bats.

The Lancers bounced back from a 6-3 setback in the opening game to beat Briar Cliff 8-7 in the nightcap of a snowy Great Plains Athletic Conference doubleheader on Thursday at Riverside Park. The games marked the first home games for the Lancers (8-9, 1-3 GPAC) this season.

"It's good to be home," said sophomore Amber Krause. "It's a little different than Tucson, but it was good to get a win."

MMC scored in the bottom of the inning each time Briar Cliff scored in the nightcap, and brought the tying run to the plate in the sixth in the opener.

"We stayed in it, gave ourselves a couple of chances," said MMC head coach Albert

While at Yankton High School, the 2013 graduate was a five-time all-state selection, a four-time all-conference pick, and a two-time state association junior champion.

Mingo, a sophomore at South Dakota State, is now one of the key contributors for a Division I women's golf program that is on quite a hot streak.

The Jackrabbits won their fourth DI title — second this season — at the Morehead State Ocala Spring Invitational earlier this week in Florida. Over its last three tournaments, SDSU has finished first, second and first.

"It's boosted all of our confidence," Mingo said by phone Thursday. "It's made traveling with the team more exciting, knowing there's a chance we could actually win."

Prior to 2015, the women's golf program had two tournament titles to its credit (from April 2011 and September 2013).

The Jacks, though, won the Lady Thunderbird Invitational on March 12-13 in Utah, and then took second at the Jackrabbit Invitational in Nevada on March 16-17 before the victory this week.

What has made the dif-

ference for SDSU? Mingo was quick to point to the addition on the Brookings campus of the Sanford-Jackrabbit Athletic Complex (SJAC) indoor facility, which opened last fall.

Having such an opportunity allowed the Jacks to practice indoors 3-4 nights a week throughout the
