• United States Sen. Bronson M. Cutting of New Mexico and at least three other persons were killed before dawn today in the crash of a twin motored transport plane of Transcontinental Western Air.
• A new program under which needy South Dakota farm families must borrow money for their subsistence needs rather than obtain it through work relief was announced today by the state relief administration.
• While millions of loyal subjects throughout the British Empire celebrated his silver jubilee in mingled carol and solemnity, King George V knelt in prayers of Thanksgiving today for completion of 25 years on the throne.

50 YEARS AGO
Friday, May 6, 1960
• The preliminary census count in Yankton is 9,130 persons, according to an announcement received this morning by Yankton Mayor C.O. Christopherson from Harley E. Fletcher of Sioux Falls, district census supervisor.
• President Eisenhower signed today the 1960 civil rights bill keyed to new protection for the voting rights of Negroes. The president called the law "a historic step forward in the field of civil rights" although Congress failed to include some of his recommendations.

Mingo said the process for getting a conditional use permit is simply paying the \$50 fee, meeting the fencing requirement, posting the notices in the newspaper, sending mailings to neighbors regarding the time and date for the permit hearing, and then holding the hearing.
"The conditional use permit is a land-use based permit. It is in no way intended to regulate daycares," he said.
While the lack of oversight within the state and city bothered several of the providers present, they all felt that they were providing high-quality care for the families using their services.
Kettering noted that, in a survey that interviewed parents in the community about what their largest concerns were, the biggest issue was making sure their children are healthy and safe at their provider.
City manager Doug Russell pointed out that a city ordinance would not improve safety.
"We need to educate the parents, too," Kettering said. "If parents know what they should be looking for when they interview a daycare provider, what they should be asking, it will help as well.
Unfortunately, there are many people in the community that are so desperate to find affordable daycare that allows them to work in order to

CHICAGO BOARD OF TRADE
Grains futures traded mostly higher Wednesday on the Chicago Board of Trade.
Wheat for July delivery rose 1.25 cents to \$5.12 a bushel; July corn gained 4 cents to \$3.73 a bushel; July soybeans dropped 9 cents to \$9.78 a bushel; and July oats were up 2.25 cents to \$2.105 a bushel.

Meanwhile, beef futures traded higher and pork fixtures were mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
June live cattle gained 0.68 cent to 96.70 cents a pound; August feeder cattle rose .07 cent at \$1.1667 a pound; June lean hogs fell 2.28 cents to 84.47 cents a pound; and May pork bellies rose 1.30 cents to 102.50 a pound.
