than a few weeks before it reopens.

"We just paid several hundred dollars to have it sandblasted off," Doherty-Stephan said. "Then, almost as soon as we open it up again, it was re-tagged with more graffiti."

The newest spray-painted symbols have been red and black initials, but before the park closed for the winter, vandals left marks that were more obscene in nature, including swastikas.

"It's getting to be a problem, and it costs a lot of money," Doherty-Stephan said. "The more money we spend cleaning up vandalism, the less money we have available for positive visitor activities and services."

Although she does not have an exact figure, Doherty-Stephan said clean-up efforts have cost the park more than \$500.

The graffiti has been hard to stop, she said, "especially since we don't have law enforcement rangers on staff who are out patrolling. I think that's one of the factors. But we will be ordering signs letting people know that it's a felony."

Doherty-Stephan said the most unfortunate aspect of the situation is that it isn't just a problem of the National Park Service.

"It prevents law-abiding citizens from enjoying their public land," she said.

"Within a couple hours (of Wednesday's closure), I had somebody calling and asking, 'When's Mulberry Bend going to open?' And I had a couple more calls (Thursday) morning. There are people who use the area for its intended purpose. (This) is denying them that opportunity, and I think that's really unfortunate."
