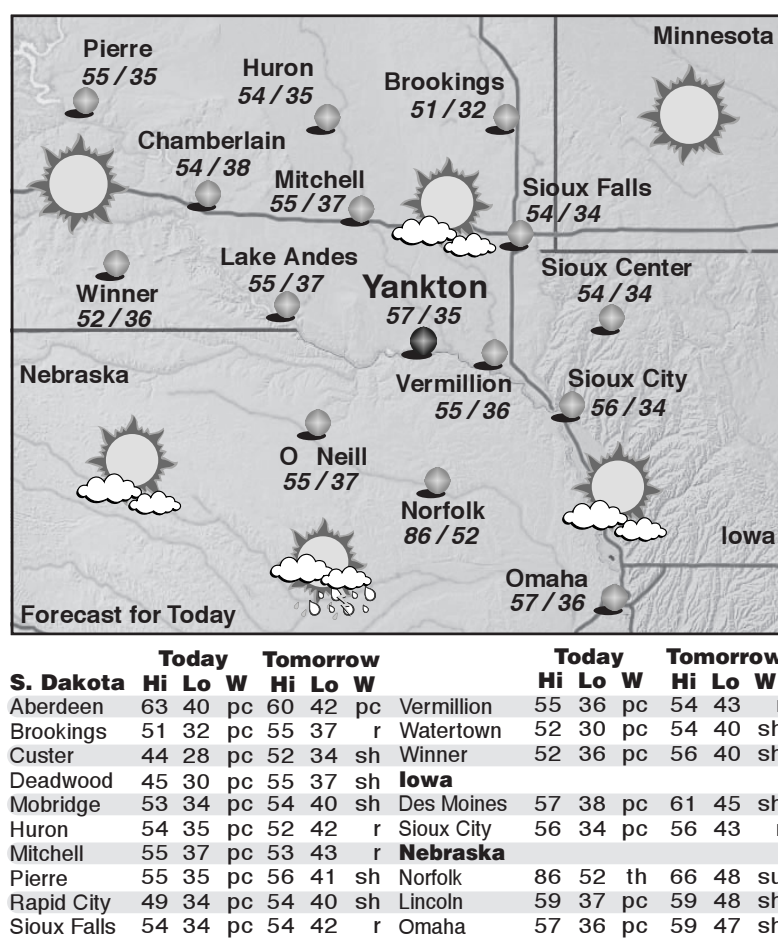

Wagner Woman One Of Three From S.D. Chosen As Bush Leadership Fellow

ST. PAUL, Minn. — A Wagner woman is among three South Dakotans to be chosen as Bush Leadership Fellows for 2010. Lisa Weddell of Wagner is one of 19 people in the Midwest to receive the honor. Other South Dakotans include Peter Anderson of Rapid City and Ryan Wise of Pierre. A lawyer by training, Weddell is program director of the Sauk and Fox Tribe of the Mississippi where she is responsible for the day-to-day operation of the tribal higher education program. She lives on the Yankton Sioux Reservation; she and her husband are traditional dancers. Weddell said, "Most classrooms fail American Indian students, leaving them without the education essential to exercise their sovereign responsibilities." She believes that instituting culturally relevant, experiential education techniques in Native schools can change this. Weddell will pursue a master's degree in educational leadership with an emphasis on experiential education at Minnesota State University, Mankato. She will also pursue a superintendent's certificate and complete an internship at the Eagle Rock School in Colorado, a renowned experiential education school that caters to diverse students from disadvantaged backgrounds. The Bush Leadership Fellows Program is dedicated to the development of leadership skills in accomplished, motivated individuals who are eager to prepare themselves for greater leadership opportunities and to create positive change in their communities. The fellowship was initiated in 1965 by one of the original executives of the 3M Corporation, Archibald G. Bush, who in 1953 created the Bush Foundation with his wife Edyth.

Grains futures traded mostly higher Friday on the Chicago Board of Trade.

- Wheat for July delivery rose 2.25 cents to \$5.105 a bushel; July corn gained .75 cent to \$3.72 a bushel; July soybeans jumped 6 cents to \$9.60 a bushel; and July oats slipped 1 cent to \$2.06 a bushel.
- Meanwhile, livestock futures traded mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
