Do you...

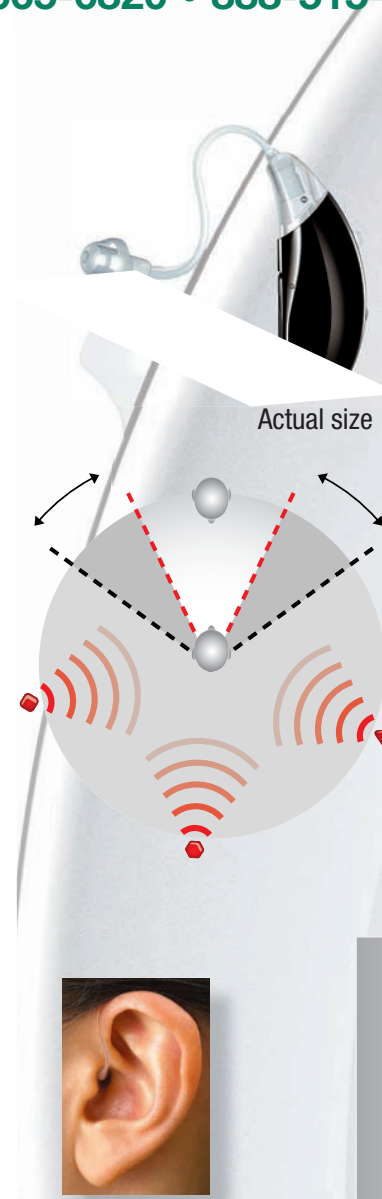
