

River Walk



The landscape of Yankton's downtown and Riverside Park area has recently taken on a new dimension with the installation of 10 sculptures by South Dakota and Nebraska artists.

RiverWalk Inc., a local nonprofit organization, began planning this public art project about two years ago but the idea was hatched more than five years ago.

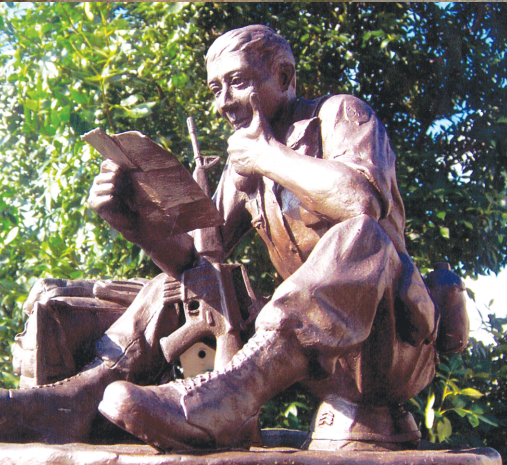
"RiverWalk is a sculpture walk from Riverside Park to the downtown area and we are proud that 2010 is the inaugural year," said Lisa Scheve, RiverWalk Inc., board president. In addition to Scheve, the RiverWalk committee includes Katie Hunhoff, Michelle Kolda, Pam Meylor and Bridgit Kasch.

This year's sculpture walk will consist of 10 juried pieces and the exhibit will change yearly.

"The RiverWalk year will run May through April," Kolda said. "The old sculptures will be taken down and the next year's sculptures will be announced each May. In April we will have an auction and gala and give people a chance to purchase the current sculptures."

"We hope to add to the project each year," Scheve said. "This year we are doing 10, hopefully next year we will be able to do 12."

Because RiverWalk Inc., is a 501c3 organization the board has had to rely on community support to get the project off the ground.
