Park Activities Planned

The park offers youth 7-12 years of age an excellent opportunity to explore South Dakota State Parks and learn about the rich natural and cultural history of South Dakota. The Junior Naturalist Program encourages youth to be physically active in the outdoors by participating in exciting recreational opportunities, including a Walk in the Park program, campground program, nature day camp and more.

Other park activities include night hikes, scenic hikes and bird hikes for beginning bird watchers, arts and crafts, special presentations and movies.

All the activities focus on helping people learn more about nature and the historical background of the area. Most of these events, except the nature hikes will be held at the amphitheaters located at Chief White Crane, Pierson Ranch and Lewis and Clark Recreation Areas.

Activities run from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Throughout the summer a weekly park newsletter called "The Explorer" is available at the Welcome Center or at any of the park entrance booths.
