LEWIS & CLARK VISITOR CENTER

The Lewis and Clark Visitor Center atop Calumet Bluff gives a hands-on introduction to Lewis and Clark's expedition. Through exhibits and movies, you learn about the history of the Missouri River, the natural history of the area and the role of the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers on the river.

The center is free of charge and handicap accessible. Spring and fall hours are 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Summer hours, beginning May 28th, expand to 8 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday to Thursday and 8 a.m.-7 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays. Call (402) 667-2546 or more information.

GAVINS POINT POWERPLANT

Gavins Point Dam is one of six main stem dams on the Missouri River. The operation of Gavins Point is vital to the management of the river. It is the last dam on the Missouri before it joins into the Mississippi. Gavins Point is essential for flood damage reduction, hydroelectric power, navigation, recreation, irrigation, water supply and quality and fish and wildlife enhancement — not only in the Yankton area but to the whole Missouri River basin. Tours of the powerplant are available 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. each Friday, Saturday and Sunday, as well as holidays. There is no fee for power plant tours. Please remember that identification is required for all visitors 17 and older entering the powerplant. Items prohibited in the powerplant include: purses or bags of any kind, cell phones, cameras and food and drink. Tours are free of charge and handicap accessible. Aquarium & Hatchery Offer Visitors a Look at Regional Aquatic Life

Enter the cool, dim world of the aquatic creatures that inhabit our river and lakes at the Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery and Aquarium. The 18 display tanks in the aquarium are entertaining and educational. Fish, reptiles and amphibians of 50 species are on display. The huge snapping turtle and the albino catfish are favorites of both adults and children. The touch screen kiosk allows you to find the state records of Iowa, Minnesota, Nebraska, and South Dakota fish.

Stroll around some of the 36 ponds where 8 species of game fish are being reared. The ponds offer great opportunities for bird watching and viewing frogs, turtles, dragonflies, and other wildlife attracted to the water.

The hatchery raises endangered Pallid sturgeon and threatened paddlefish. Future broodstock of the Pallid sturgeon are also

housed at the hatchery. Guided tours of the sturgeon buildings can be arranged by contacting the hatchery. The hatchery is one of 70 National Fish Hatcheries or Fish Technology Centers in the United States.

Help out the hatchery by joining "Friends of Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery." The friends group, a 501c3 charitable organization, helps with events, maintenance and funding of hatchery projects. Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery is located west of Yankton on Highway 52. Hatchery hours are 8 a.m.-4 p.m. daily, and aquarium hours are 10 a.m.-4 p.m. daily May through September, and Monday through Friday in April and October.
