Est. 1868 ~ 27.4 acres, first burial in 1876. Many prominent figures from Yankton history are buried at the cemetery including: General Custer's bandleader, several Territorial Governors, State Senators and Congressmen and the notorious Jack McCall, who was hung for Wild Bill Hickok's murder


