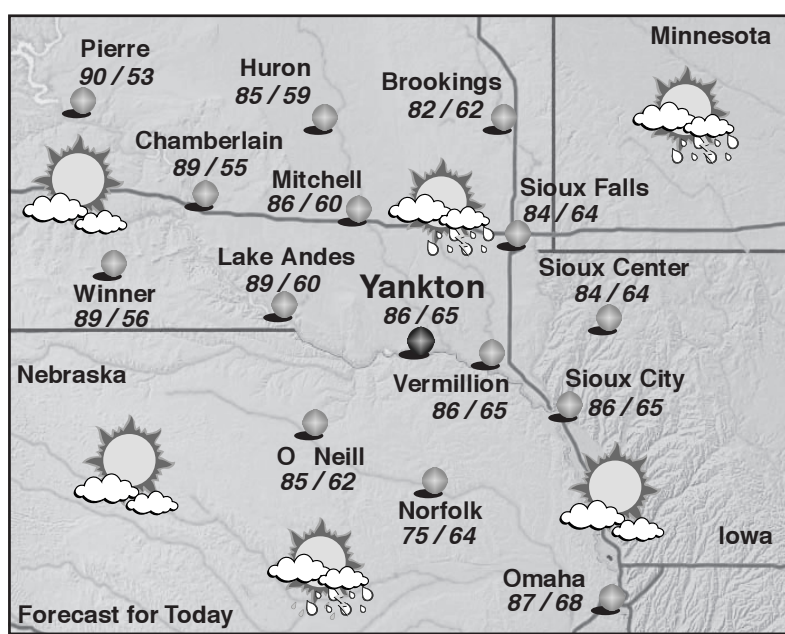

CHICAGO BOARD OF TRADE

Wheat for July delivery climbed 2.25 cents to \$4.72 a bushel, while July corn jumped 7 cents to \$3.69 a bushel and oats for July delivery added 2 cents to \$1.96 a bushel. July soybeans lost 3 cents to \$9.41 a bushel. Meanwhile, beef futures fell and pork futures traded higher on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. June live cattle slipped 0.08 cent to 91.37 cents a pound; August feeder cattle shed 0.27 cent to \$1.1015 a pound; June lean hogs rose 1.2 cents to 81.45 cents a pound; and July pork bellies advanced 2 cents to \$1.015 a pound.

City Commission To Introduce Wind Energy Ordinance Monday

 The Yankton City Commission will introduce a wind energy conversion system ordinance Monday. If it is eventually approved, the ordinance would allow wind towers with a conditional-use permit in Yankton's B-2 Highway Business Districts, Industrial Districts and certain new residential areas when established as a community unit plan.

A public hearing on the ordinance will be established for June 14. Also Monday, the commission will consider a flood plain management ordinance, several plats, an annexation and the transfer of some entitlements for Chan Gurney Municipal Airport. The meeting gets under way at 7 p.m. in the City of Yankton Meeting Room, located at the Technical Education Center, 1200 W. 21st St.
