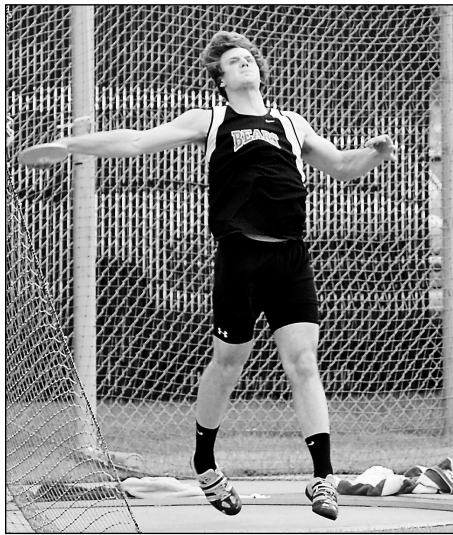

Pacesetter Championships June 12-13 in Huron
