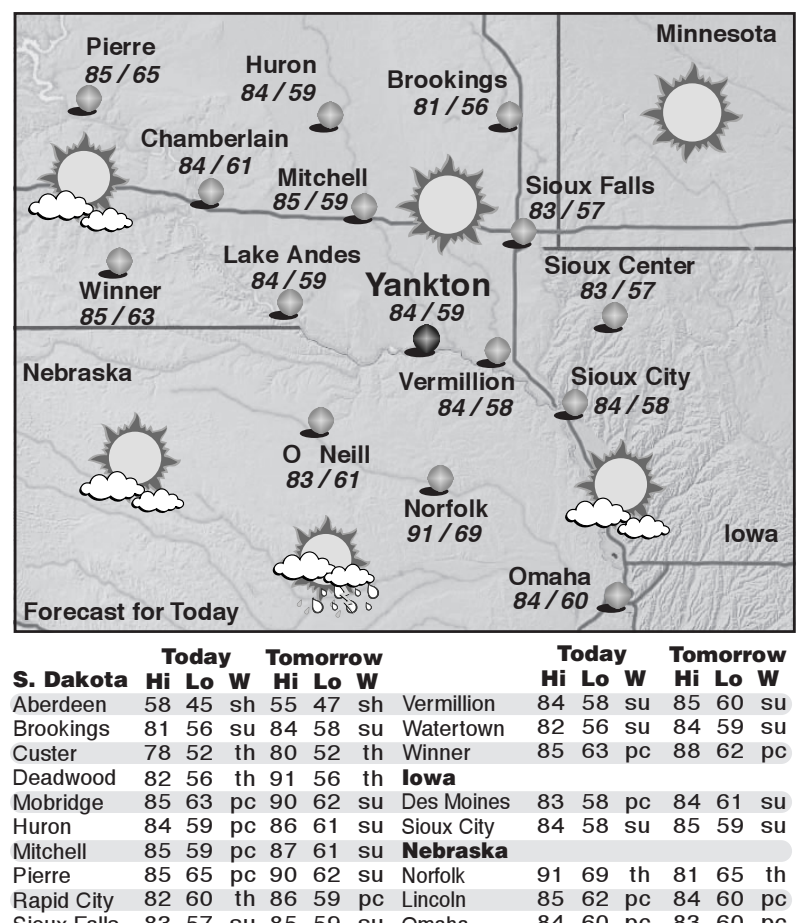

75 YEARS AGO

Monday, May 27, 1935

Friday, May 27, 1960
 Inclusion of an antisegregation amendment raised questions today about Senate acceptance of the first general school construction bill ever passed by the House. A long, wrangling session ended in authorizing \$1,300,000 in federal grants over a four-year period to help with construction of public school classrooms. The world's airlines, displays, souvenirs and movies will be in Yankton Monday to highlight the city's five-day salute to aviation. Mayor Clayton O. Christopherson has proclaimed this week as Yankton Aviation Week in recognition of the importance of scheduled air transportation in the city and state.

CHICAGO BOARD OF TRADE

Wheat for July delivery gained 1.25 cents to \$4.6175 a bushel, while July corn jumped 7.25 cents to \$3.715 a bushel and oats for July delivery rose 1 cent to \$1.925 a bushel. July soybeans climbed 7.5 cents to \$9.38 a bushel. Meanwhile, beef futures traded higher and pork futures were mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. June live cattle added 0.78 cent to 90.8 cents a pound; August feeder cattle rose 1.03 cents to \$1.083 a pound; June lean hogs edged up 0.5 cent to 81.65 cents a pound; and July pork bellies slipped 0.05 cent to \$1.026 a pound.
