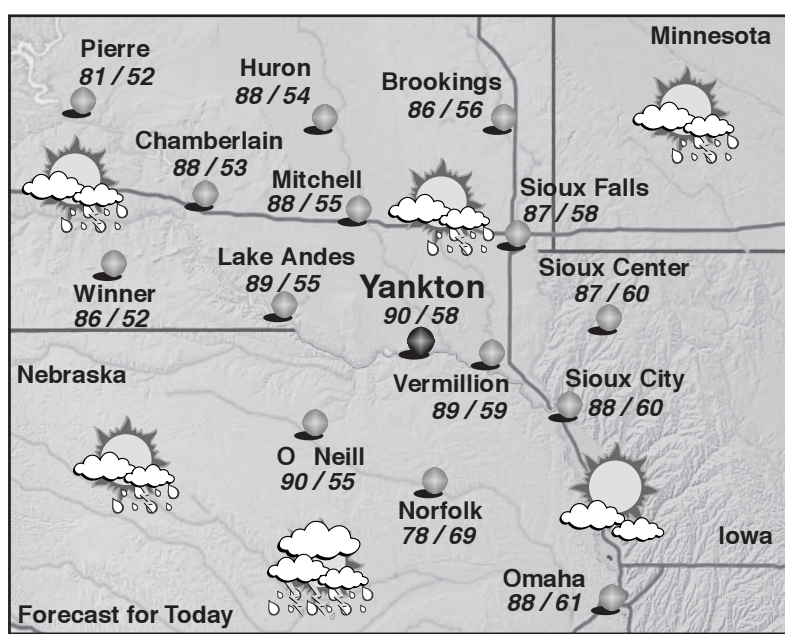

### 75 YEARS AGO

**Wednesday, May 29, 1935**  
Just 60 years after the first class graduated, a senior class of Yankton High school will graduate tonight. Eighty-five seniors, their teachers, friends and a large audience of interested townsfolk are expected also to be in attendance.  
The French liner Normandie, the world's largest ship, sails today on her maiden voyage to New York in the hope of proving herself the fastest vessel afloat. Financial circles said she would carry a heavy shipment of gold, a new drain on the vaults of the bank of France as the government pushed its battle to save the franc from devaluation.

**Wednesday, May 29, 1985**  
The Yankton City Commission Tuesday night passed by a 5-4 vote an ordinance prohibiting nude dancing and stripping. The ordinance, which would ban nude dancing at the Cockatoo Bar, is identical to statutes in Aberdeen and Sioux Falls.  
President Reagan is proposing a vast tax overhaul with lower rates, larger exemptions and fewer deductions - a system he promises will lift the poor and make everybody's neighbor pay a share.

Wheat for July delivery dropped 10 cents to \$4.5775 a bushel, while July corn plummeted 14.25 cents to \$3.59 a bushel and oats for July delivery lost 5.5 cents to \$1.91 a bushel. July soybeans sank 14 cents to \$9.3775 a bushel.  
June live cattle fell 1.05 cents to 90.52 cents a pound, August feeder cattle slipped 0.08 cent to \$1.0942 a pound; June lean hogs gained 0.68 cent to 81.85 cents a pound; and July pork bellies rose 0.85 cent to \$1.029 a pound.
