They lived in the White River, South Dakota area from 1958 to 1963 where he worked as a ranch hand. He graduated from Springfield Teachers College in Springfield, South Dakota in 1966. They moved to Menominee, Nebraska and lived there until moving to Fordyce, Nebraska in 1973. Bob worked as a mechanic

for Ken Bitterman Ford in Yankton from 1966 to 1982. He operated Evans Auto Repair in Yankton from 1982 to 1986. He drove a milk truck for Dodge Dairy from 1986 to 1990 and then began Evans Milk Hauling and hauled milk independently until 2000. In 1995 they moved to Leesterville, South Dakota. He drove a school bus for the Crofton Public School until 2005 and then drove a school bus for the Yankton Public School and worked as a custodian for RTEC in Yankton until his health caused him to retire in December of 2009. They moved to Crofton in the fall of 2009.

Bob was a member of the St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church and the Crofton American Legion Post 128. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, bowling, playing cards, camping, gardening, traveling and spending time with his family.
