city of South Dakota won five events, while one former area athlete won an individual title for South Dakota State.

USD freshman Cody Snyder, a former Andes Central standout, won the college men's discus with a mark of 162-feet-3.

It was the second best mark of the season for Snyder, who said he was gunning for something further.

"Honestly, I was really shooting for 170, because that would get me closer to (NCAA regionals)," he said. "I'm not quite there, but I feel like I could get there at conference."

Because the Coyotes travel to the Great West Conference Outdoor Championships early next week, USD had fewer athletes competing in multiple events. Instead, certain athletes were either looking to better their qualifying times or make the conference squad.

"This was more of a fine-tuning meet for us," Snyder said. "It was still fun to compete in a huge meet like this."

The USD men won the 400-meter relay with a school-record clocking of 40.90, nearly a full second ahead of South Dakota State. The time also bumped USD to No. 1 in the Great West Conference.

The quartet for the Coyotes was Michael Burrus, Brandon Kovash, Jared Clement and Matt Kerswell.

Kerswill later won the men's 200-meter dash in a time of 21.83, with teammate Jared Clement finished second.

On the women's side, the Coyotes won three events.

Alexa Duling was first in the 200-meter dash (24.43). Carol Miller was first in the 800

(2:18.01) and Jasmine Mosley won the shot put with a toss of 47 feet, 4.5 inches.

Though, Mosley admitted later that she was far from satisfied.

"All I wanted to do was better my own mark before the conference meet, and this meet was a good chance to do that," Mosley said. "I wasn't satisfied at all, but at least I'm staying in a consistent pattern."

"I just have to move forward." Moving forward was a goal for South Dakota State's Luke Leischner, a native of Parkston.

The two-time defending champion in the men's 400-meter dash won for a third-straight year with a first-place clocking of 47.54 on Friday.

"I wanted to get a little faster time for some bigger things coming up," Leischner said, referring to next week's Summit League outdoor meet and the NCAA regionals.

"It wasn't the greatest time, but I'll take it." Like USD, the Jackrabbits have their conference meet soon after the Dakota Relays, unlike previous years where there were two weeks between each.

There was a heavy local presence in the feature college women's 800-meter run, as Augustana's Molly Kokesch (Scotland) and SDSU's Krista Creager (Yankton) finished 1-2, respectively.

One of the biggest stories on Friday wasn't a record time, but instead an injury.

Near the end of the high school girls' 100-meter dash, Oldham-Ramona-Rutland standout sprinter Carly Carper pulled her right hamstring and crumbled to the track.

The crowd at Howard Wood Field went silent as Carper was attended to by medical personnel.

It was a similar sight to last year's state meet, when former Rapid City Central standout Jasmyne King suffered a leg injury during the 400-meter dash.
