Notice is given that Paul Gustad, 30491 447th Ave, Volin SD 57072 has filed an application for a water permit to appropriate 1.78 cubic feet of water per second from one well to be completed into the Missouri-Elk Point Aquifer (approximately 140 feet deep) located in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17 for irrigation of 320 acres located in the NW 1/4 Section 17 and NE 1/4 Section 18; all in T94N-R54W.

Pursuant to SDCL 46-2A-2, the Chief Engineer recommends APPROVAL of Application No. 7246-3 because 1) unappropriated water is available, 2) existing rights will not be unlawfully impaired, 3) it is a beneficial use of water, and 4) it is in the public interest. In accordance with SDCL 46-2A-23, the Chief Engineer will act on this application, as recommended, unless a petition is filed opposing the application or the applicant files a petition contesting the Chief Engineer's recommendation. If a petition opposing the application or contesting the recommendation is filed, then a hearing will be scheduled and the Water Management Board will consider this application. Notice of the hearing will be given to the applicant and any person filing a petition.

Any person interested in opposing or supporting this application or recommendation must file a written petition with BOTH the applicant and Chief Engineer. The applicant must file a petition if contesting the Chief Engineer's recommendation. A petition filed by either an interested person or the applicant must be filed by June 6, 2011.

the Missouri River ecosystem to not transfer invasive species.

"It not only has a direct effect on the river," she said. "It also causes significant damage to boat engines, for example. If an engine gets zebra mussels, it can be a big problem because they will grow a colony in the engine and damage it. There are plant species that have similar effects, as well."

Currently, Asian carp and zebra mussels exist in the Missouri River below Gavins Point Dam but, they haven't spread into Lewis and Clark

Lake. Doherty-Stephan said through education, awareness and a few simple steps, the spread of these species can be prevented.

"We just want to help keep the amazing resource that is the river as pristine as possible," Doherty-Stephan said.

Boaters can prevent the spread of invasives by taking three simple steps, every time they pull their boat and other equipment from the water they should:

- clean all mud and vegetation from your boat, motor, trailer and other equipment;
- drain all water from your live wells, bait wells and bilge areas; and
- always allow your boat and other equipment to thoroughly dry before launching in another waterway.

Schroeder also asked that community members be reminded that this is the first weekend for Friday and Saturday evening programs at the park.

"Typically, a visitor to one of the programs would also need a park pass to get in the park," she said. "This weekend, gives residents a chance to come out and experience an evening program and see what we offer without having to buy a park pass."
