Comedy Youth Camp Slated For Norfolk

NORFOLK, Neb. — Summer has never been so funny. Junior high and high school students attending the Viero Great American Comedy Festival's youth camp in Norfolk, Neb., in June will have the opportunity to hone one-liners, rub elbows with established comedians and build a repertoire of skills useful in real-life situations. Camp director LuAnn Schindler — a speech and drama coach in Northeast Nebraska for 20-plus years — said the camp has been streamlined this year to accommodate teens' hectic summer schedules.

"Instead of running a full week, this summer's classes will be held Wednesday through Friday at Northeast Community College. Campers get the same amount of instruction time in a more compact time period," Schindler said.

Another change allows students to stay on campus or to commute from their homes. Schindler said the commuter option benefits students who have scheduling conflicts but still want to participate.

During the three-day camp — June 15-17 — students create work that will be showcased in an "after hours" teen show at Divots, where they will perform alongside professional comedians. The teen show is set for 9:30 p.m. on Friday, June 17.

"It's the most fun and rewarding experience I've been fortunate to work with," said Schindler, who said students involved in high school speech and drama would particularly benefit from attending.

Working with creative instructors sets this unique educational opportunity apart from other camps. This year's instructors include a veteran of The Second City and an instructor from the largest comedy school in America.

Megan Grano, part of The Second City comedy troupe, returns as a camp instructor, teaching sketch comedy and improv.

"Life is a heck of a lot easier with a great sense of humor," she said. Grano incorporates that premise into her sessions, which explains the basics of sketch writing. When Grano started at Second City, sketch scenes ran up to 15 minutes.

But in a world filled with technology and social networking, comedy is adapting, and students will experience that fast-paced thrill of comedy.

"Nowadays, most scenes are about two minutes, especially when it comes to the Web," she said.

Joining Grano as a stand-up comedy instructor is Kurtis Matthews of the San Francisco Comedy College.

Matthews said a funny person will tell more jokes that do not work in their lifetime than ones that do. It boils down to a desire to bring joy to other people.

"Getting laughs is big fun and hugely rewarding," he said. The rewarding elements of attending camp stand out to Schindler. Past attendees have taken the skills they have fine-tuned in camp and spun those talents into gold.

"Several alumni have been fortunate to earn medals at state speech, primarily in entertainment, humorous prose, duet acting and original interpretation of drama, and at state one-act competitions."

The accolades extend to other performance areas, too. One past camp participant now travels with the Young Americans, another is making the rounds at comedy clubs in Los Angeles, and several have incorporated what they learned into their music careers.

"Campers learn so much more than comedy," Schindler said. Several high schools from across the state have approached Schindler about sending groups of speech and drama students to this summer's camp.

"We may not be considered a mainstream speech or theater arts summer program, but I've seen a deep-rooted transformation in several students while at camp, and they've parlayed this skill set into personal and professional success," she said.

Schindler said it's rewarding to watch each student's confidence and stage presence increase.

"By the final performance, students' poise and self-confidence shine. They are fearless, even if the butterflies consider flying," she said.

Matthews addresses performance fears by teaching rehearsal and performance techniques, in addition to the structure of all comedy.

"I will assist in creating an effective comedy routine that can be delivered onstage, at home, or to get out of a traffic ticket," he said with a smile.

All joking aside, Grano said skills, such as thinking on your feet and responding with humor, come in handy during real-life situations, like in the classroom or during college interviews.
