leg is right behind you instead of out to the side — just make sure you do everything right in the last two hurdles," Dvorak said.

Lillie followed for the Bucks earning six points for his third place finish in the 110 hurdles. Lillie had qualified Friday for the event after placing seventh. Moving up four spots was what he had hoped to do.

"It's always good competition in the hurdles," he said. "Yesterday was the worst race I had ever ran, so I knew I couldn't do any worse than that. I have shoulder problems and my hammy is pretty tight, but it didn't affect me at all today."

Ty Soulek took fourth in the discus yesterday and then followed with a sixth place finish in the boys' shot put on Day 2. Soulek said he was a little disappointed in how he performed, but he enjoyed the opportunity to compete at state.

"I didn't compete my best, I've been throwing 50's this season, but it's been going down lately," Soulek said. "It was good as a junior to come down and compete at state. Next year, it'll be good with a lot more experience. I'm excited for next year."

Placing in two events was a great achievement and Soulek said he was proud of his finishes after working hard all year.

Two Gazelles had to fight along one another in the girls' 1600-meter run. Whitelee Larson finished sixth ahead of teammate Jenna Grossenburg who took eighth, less than three seconds behind Larson.

Larson took sixth in the 800 yesterday and said running both races helps her pace herself.

"The 1600 is definitely a lot slower and more relaxed than the 800," she said. "It's helped running the 800 and 1600 because once you're halfway done with the 1600, all you have left is an 800. I keep that pace up throughout it and then the last 400 try to pick it up."

Grossenburg also placed, earning third in the 3200. Unlike Larson who doubled her race, Grossenburg cut hers in half, which helps.

"The mile is faster and in the 3200 it's so long — you just keep thinking 'Oh, I have a mile and a half still left,'" she said. "It was tough, I

a seventh place finish in the medley (4:34.7).

"I knew that if I cleared five foot, I would have a chance of placing," O'Malley said of the high jump. "I was trying to place in all my events, so I think that helped me get that five foot mark."

Going into the finals of the discus, Haley Hinseth of Irene-Wakonda posted the longest throw, but it was Mitchell Christian's Mariah Nelson winning the discus. The junior from Irene-Wakonda ended her state meet with two medals including a fourth place finish in the shot put.

Cailey Roth of Freeman earned her first state individual on Friday in the 3200 and followed that up with a seventh place finish in the 1600 (5:34.7). Also for Freeman, Kristina Nash placed sixth in the 300-meter hurdles (49.17) and seventh in the 1600 relay (4:18.9).

Other individuals on the girls side were Anna Leloux of Parker third in the discus (116-10), Irene-Wakonda's Lauren Sokolowski fourth in the 100-meter hurdles (15.81) and Sam Blake of Center-ville fifth in the discus (112-8).

On the boys side, Duane Jongeling of Parker might only be a sophomore, but has the runner has two third place medals under his belt. Jongeling finished his state meet with a third place finish in the 1600 (4:33.08), which came after a third-place finish in the 3200.

"I just tried to sit with the leaders as long as I could," Jongeling said. "The lap that I was leading, I just wanted to see how long I could keep that pace. I just pushed it the last 150 (meters) to beat my school record — which I did (by seven-tenths of a second)."

The Parker native also grabbed an first place win in the medley relay (3:44.6) helping Jongeling

out in relay was Blake Reynolds, Mark Olson and Tristen Erickson.

As Colter Florey came into the final meet of the season, the Andes Central jumper had a qualifying high jump of 6-feet-2.5 and landed in second (6-1). Florey also tallied a fifth place finish in the triple jump (41-5.75).

"My goal in the triple jump was to place better than I did last year," Florey said. "My goal in the high jump was to place in the top three. I'm definitely not disappointed."

Spencer Bloch of Scotland had a solid final meet of his high school career before he heads off to play football at Dakota Wesleyan University. Bloch notched second in the discus (144-9), just a day after he placed third in the shot put.

Trey Waltner failed to qualify for the 110-meter finals, but he was able to notch a third place finish in the 300-meter hurdles (41.9). The Freeman native high school running career might be over and he is happy to end his career on this note.

"It was my last race and I just wanted to leave everything out there," Waltner said. "That's all you can do."

Tyler Handel of Menno was able to handle his back pains for at least one more day placing fourth in the 100-meter dash (11.4) and sixth place in the 400-meter relay (46.2).

Marion's Brady Viet grabbed two finalist spots on day two and scored fifth in the 200-meter dash (23.3) and eighth in the 400-meter dash (52.5).

Cody Bussell of Parker placed fifth in the high jump with a jump of 5-feet-11.

Irene-Wakonda's Garrett Anderson placed sixth in the 300 hurdles (43.3) and Sam Kiger sixth in the discus (133-0). The Eagles also nabbed a third place in the 400 relay (45.3).

The Avon Pirates scored 12 points on a second place finish in the medley relay (3:47.8) and fifth place in the 1600 relay (3:36.1).
