in the Big Ten and fifth in NCAA Division I on the season.

DALLAS, Texas — The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) announced Wednesday the members of the 2012 NFF Hampshire Honor Society, which is comprised of college football players from all divisions of play who each maintained a cumulative 3.2 GPA or better throughout their college career. A total of 721 players from 232 schools qualified for membership in the society's sixth year, marking this year's class as the largest since the program's creation in 2007.
