tus, to fill the seat being vacated by the retirement of Sen. Ben Nelson, also a Democrat. Republicans have made the seat one of their top targets in the 2012 election.

Kerrey will face the winner of next week's GOP primary, which includes Nebraska Attorney General Jon Bruning, State Treasurer Don Stenberg and Valentine state Sen. Deb Fischer.

The former senator's statement came on the heels of an announcement by Obama, who said in an interview Wednesday that he supports same-sex marriage.

Kerrey campaign spokesman Chris Triebisch said same-sex marriage hasn't surfaced as a major issue in Nebraska's U.S. Senate race so far, and he expected that Kerrey would continue to focus on health care, the economy and agriculture.

"The president's statement yesterday brings this into the news right now, but I still don't think it changes the whole dynamic of what issues are most important to Nebraskans right now," Triebisch said. "That's our sense of things. It is obviously a groundbreaking statement yesterday, so it deserves some attention. But when all is said and done, is it going to be a major issue in this campaign? No."

In 2006, the University of South Dakota sought approval to pursue eligibility to compete at Division I. The board approved requests from Black Hills State University and South Dakota School of Mines and Technology in 2010 to pursue a move from NIAA to NCAA Division II.

In addition to GPA, credit hours and proficiency exams, the report also examined ACT scores, academic scholarship recipients and graduation and retention rates.

"The overarching theme that emerges from this report is that, when compared across a variety of indicators, athletes and non-athletes perform as similar levels," the report stated.
