tive colitis inflames only the large intestine (colon). Symptoms can include abdominal pain, persistent diarrhea, rectal bleeding, fever, weight loss and fatigue.

Jessie said something that has helped the family deal with Sean's symptoms is the Crohn's and Colitis support group in Yankton.

"We appreciate the support we've gotten from the group here in town," she said. "They're there for anything that we need."

The group, which has been in Yankton for 12 years, offers information and support for patients with Crohn's or Colitis and their family and friends, said Kathy Ryken, one of the group's facilitators and board member for the state CCFA.

"Some meetings we just share how we're feeling and how we're doing, and some meetings we provide education with information and speakers," she said.

Jessie said neither her nor her husband Matt suffer from Crohn's disease, so it can be challenging to understand what Sean is going through. Meeting others with the disease has helped immensely, she said.

"It's helpful when adults with Crohn's can explain to us what bothers them or what helps them, and we can try those things with Sean, because he's too little to verbalize what bothers him," Jessie said.

The support group meets the third Tuesday of every month at 6:45 p.m. at the Avera Sacred Heart Campus Pavilion at 409 Summit. For more information, contact Ryken at 605-665-8667.

"I'd just like to let people know that we're out there if they need help, even if it's just for a phone call," Ryken said.

While the Yankton support group and Remicade infusions are helping, the Scotts continue to look for more answers for Sean, as the effectiveness of his current treatment likely won't last very long.

"Sean is really young, but the average life span for effectiveness for Remicade is about five years, which means when it stops working, we need a new medicine," Jessie said.

That's where the upcoming walk-a-thon can help, she said.

"If there's no funding, there's no research and there's no new medicine," Jessie said. "So at this time, this is his last resort. We need to have more fundraising done so studies can be conducted and they can approve other medicine for him.'

"Take Steps for Crohn's & Colitis" is the CCFA's national evening walk and celebration, with 158 walk sites across the country. Throughout the year, the walk program enables patient families to join together with their local community to build visibility and awareness about Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis while raising funds. Celebrating its fifth anniversary, Take Steps has raised more than \$30 million for research and patient support services.

"It's a fun event," said Jessie, who participated in the Sioux Falls walk last year with her family. "It's just a walk, so it's not taxing on people to do it. And it's really the only way for people to hope for something else."

Ŵitĥ the walk being the state CCFA's main fundraiser, Ryken encouraged everyone to take part in the event and help out with the cause.

'It would be fun to fill that park with people coming to support us and help us get more funding so people like Sean won't have to go through what they do," she said.
