Parkston's Van Laecken Leads SDHSC Winners

SIOUX FALLS — South Dakota's all-time winningest girls' basketball coach Rob Van Laecken of Parkston highlights the 2012 winner Coach of the Year award winners, announced by the South Dakota High School Coaches Association.

Van Laecken passed Fred Tibbetts on the career wins list last season and guided the Lady Trojans to a Class A state tournament runner-up finish.

Among the other winners are Water-town's Vicki Fischer (gymnastics), Pierre's Ryan Noyes (wrestling), Sioux Falls O'Gorman's Derek Robey (boys' basketball), Sioux Falls Lincoln's Jim Dorman (athletic director) and Dimock's Dan Sudbeck (official).

The winners will be recognized at the annual awards banquet in Aberdeen on Wednesday, July 18, in conjunction with the summer coaches' clinic.

SIOUX FALLS — Augustana head men's basketball coach Tom Biller announced Tuesday the signing of St. Cloud, Minn., native Joe Burt for the 2012-13 season.

Burt is a 6-foot-2, 190-pound guard who prepped at Cathedral High School in St. Cloud. He left CHS as the school's all-time leader in scoring and assists. Burt was a four-year letterwinner and starter.

As a senior in 2011-12, Burt averaged 17.2 points, 7.1 rebounds and 6.0 assists per game. He was named all-state and was the St. Cloud Times Area Player of the Year.

Burt joins Daniel Jansen (Orange City, Iowa), Zach Huiskens (Chandler, Minn.), Jack Preston (Basingstoke, Hampshire, England), Cass Schilling (Ellsworth, Minn.), Tanner Odegaard (Brookings) and Brandon Stubbs (Pleasant Hill, Iowa) in Biller's 2012-13 recruiting class.
