VERMILLION — University of South Dakota head tennis coach Malcolm Gilreath is pleased to announce the signings of Dragana Brankovic (Frankfurt, Germany) and Ana Jelena Vujosevic (Monza, Italy) to national letters of

intent. Gilreath also announced that Rymma Maslova (Kiev, Ukraine) will transfer to USD from University of Nevada.

"We are excited to welcome Dragana, Ana and Rymma to the program," said Gilreath. "They are great people who can make a difference at USD both on the court and in the classroom. In terms of tennis, they will contribute immediate depth throughout our lineup."

Brankovic is 123-43 since 2004. She has international playing experience and has been successful in Germany at both the regional and national level. She won the EU Cup in 2012 and has experience playing in ETA/ITF tournaments.

Vujosevic was born in Monza, but resides in Bar, Montenegro, and is a Montenegrin citizen. She started playing tennis at the age of six, was coached by Gianluca Pozzi, the only Italian to have played in the quarterfinals of Wimbledon, and spent three years at Niki Pilic Tennis Academy in Germany. Vujosevic was ranked as high as No. 2 in Montenegro (U18).

Maslova made her way to Las Vegas, Nevada, at the urging of her tennis coach and father, Victor. She enrolled at the No Quit Tennis Academy where she received instruction from Adam Carey. She has spent the last two seasons at Nevada where she has compiled eight wins in singles play and nine wins in doubles play.

The trio join a program that finished 16-11 overall and qualified for the Summit League Tournament in its first season of eligibility.
