WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Bon Homme County, Hutchinson County, and Yankton County, South Dakota, jointly acting upon Notice of Hearing on Petitions for the formation of the proposed Scotland Rural Fire Protection District, having been given by the County Auditor of Bon Homme County, South Dakota under date of 24th day January, 2014, having been given by the County Auditor of Hutchinson County, South Dakota under date of 24th day of January, 2014, and pursuant to the Certificate of the County Auditor of Bon Homme County, Hutchinson County and of Yank-

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ton County, South Dakota on file in the office of the respective County Auditor, reference to which Notice of Hearing and Certificate is hereby made and incorporated herein by this reference, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Bon Homme, Hutchinson and Yankton County, South Dakota, at a joint meeting, this 28th day of March, 2014 at 7:00 o'clock P.M., in the City of Tyndall, Bon Homme County, South Dakota, having met, and all persons residing in or owning taxable property within the proposed district having had an opportunity to be heard respecting the formation of said District or the location of the boundaries thereof, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Bon Homme, Hutchinson & Yankton County, South Dakota, have determined that the proposed Scotland Rural Fire Protection District is suited to the general fire protection policy of Bon Homme, Hutchinson & Yankton County, South Dakota, as a whole, and having determined that the boundaries of the proposed district, as suggested in the Petition now on file herein in this matter, reference to which is hereby made and incorporated herein by this preference, and having been otherwise fully advised in the premises, and good cause having been shown and now appearing.
