PIERRE — The Yankton Bucks finished fourth in the Eastern South Dakota Conference boys' tennis tournament on Friday in Pierre.

Mitchell ran away with the team title with 430 points. Brandon Valley finished second at 199, followed by Aberdeen Central (189) and The Bucks (182).

The Bucks had a strong showing in singles play, with three runner-up finishes. Jason Shindler earned a runner-up finish at flight two, dropping a 10-5 decision to Mitchell's Beau Brown in the final.

Bradford Frick was a second place finisher at flight five, dropping a 10-5 decision to Aberdeen's Alex Grandbois. Hunter Rockne also finished second, falling to Mitchell's Gray Determan in the flight six final.

Luke Rockne (flight one) and Paul Fanta (flight four) each earned fourth place finishes. Greg Hauer earned the consolation title at flight three.

Hauer and Fanta placed third at flight two doubles. Luke Rockne and Shindler finished sixth at flight one doubles.

Ethan-Parkston Sweeps Home Meet

PARKSTON — Ethan-Parkston combined to win 13 events on the way to sweeping the team track titles at Friday's Ethan-Parkston Relays in Parkston.

On both sides, Ethan-Parkston defeated Bon Homme, by 12 points in the boys' division and by 16 points in the girls'.

Wes Dvorak led the E-P boys with three individual titles, in the 100-meter dash (11.18), 110 hurdles (15.06) and long jump (20-11). Teammates Nick Zolnowsky won the 3200 (11:16.58), Camden Myers won the high jump (6-4) and Kyle Schnabel was first in the triple jump (37-1).

On the girls' side, there were no double winners. For Ethan-Parkston, Patience Nesheim won the 400 (1:03.6), Lexy Leischner won the 3200 (13:15.93), Kailie Schnabel won the shot put (36-1) and Justene Alley won in the triple jump (31-9).

Blasius Memorial Inv. KIMBALL — Mount Vernon-Plankinton dominated the Lezlie Blasius Memorial Invite on Friday in Kimball, sweeping the team track titles.

The girls' division was especially one side, as MVP won 13 events on the way to 258 total points. Kimball-White Lake was a distant second at 95.

Winning titles for MVP were Camie Walz in the 400 (1:04.47), Wyl Westendorf in the 1600 (5:52.87), Savannah

Michael Olson won the 800 (2:05.2), Eric Hunstad won the 300 hurdles (42.3) and Adam Harms won the discus (136-10).

On the girls' side, Garretson won six events to finish first overall. Sioux Valley edged Parker 109.5-109 for second place.

Parker's Brittany Olson won the 400 (1:00.4). On the boys' side, Mount Vernon-Plankinton won just four events, but finished first overall with 198 points. James Valley Christian was a distant second at 119.

Andes Central's Joey Evans was first in the long jump (18-8.75) and triple jump (39-1), and the Eagles also won the 400 relay.

Big East Conference GARRETSON — Five different athletes won individual events as the Parker boys' track team won the Big East Conference title at the league meet Friday in Garretson.

Parker rolled up 165 total points for first place. Garretson was the girls' champion with 162 points.

Zack Anderson was a double winner for the Parker boys, taking first in the long jump (19-6.5) and triple jump (41-1.5). Teammates Tristen Erickson won the 400 (50.5).

In area finishes, Beresford's Riley Schaa won the 1600 (4:44.93) and Vermillion's won the shot put (50.5).
