Meyer Memorial Services Scheduled

ABERDEEN, S.D. (AP) — Memorial services have been scheduled in South Dakota and Tennessee for Don Meyer, one of the nation's winningest basketball coaches. He died Sunday in his Aberdeen home at age 69. Meyer was diagnosed with inoperable cancer after a September 2008 car accident. Northern State University says a public service will be held at 3 p.m. Saturday in the Barnett Center in Aberdeen on the court named for the former men's basketball coach. A second memorial service will be held June 1 at Lipscomb University in Nashville, Tennessee, on Don Meyer Court in Allen Arena. Meyer led his teams into the playoffs 19 times and compiled a 923-324 during his 38-year career, most of which he spent at Lipscomb and Northern State.

Theft Charge Against Nebraska's Banderas Dismissed

LINCOLN, Neb. (AP) — A felony theft charge against Nebraska linebacker Josh Banderas has been dismissed. Lancaster County Attorney Joe Kelly said Monday night that Banderas will enter a pre-trial diversion program rather than face charges in the theft of seven bicycles last week. Banderas is eligible for diversion because he has no prior felony convictions. Lincoln police on May 12 arrested Banderas and Nebraska track athlete Lucas Keifer in a pickup loaded with mountain bikes. A witness spotted them using bolt cutters to remove bikes from racks near university housing.

to a certain point and then look for teams outside of Yankton," he added. "I don't think it would impact just Yankton, it would impact the whole state."

Benjamin agreed, saying that the sport could prosper even further with the decision. The current players, though, are understandably excited for the chance to play for a state championship.

"We're really excited about having a state tournament," Benjamin said. Part of being sanctioned could mean increased recognition across the state, she added.

"Before, soccer was just a club thing, it didn't feel like we were part of the regular sports," Benjamin said. "Now I think that changes."

"Now it's like you feel part of something."

The sticking point for many of the districts, including Yankton, was how to pay for the sport.

The Yankton School District had a structural deficit of approximately \$850,000, according to the budget pre-
