Man Accused Of Raping
Woman In Abuse Shelter

SIoux FALLS (AP) — A
Sioux Falls man is accused of
breaking into a shelter for
domestic abuse victims and
raping a woman while her
child slept nearby.

Authorities allege that
Heath Big Eagle, 47, entered
the woman's room at the
shelter through an unlocked
window between 3 a.m. and
4 a.m. Monday, forced the
woman to take methamphet-
amine and sexually assaulted
her.

The Associated Press
does not identify victims of
sex crimes.

Big Eagle faces second-de-
gree rape and first-degree
burglary charges, along with
violating a protection order.
Judge John Hinrichs set
bond at \$50,000 cash during
Big Eagle's initial court ap-
pearance on Tuesday. Big
Eagle did not immediately
enter pleas. He could face up
to 75 years in prison if
convicted.

The My Sister Friends
House shelter issued a state-
ment calling the alleged inci-
dent "an extremely rare

occurrence at a shelter dedi-
cated to providing safety and
support to victims of domes-
tic and sexual violence."
"We know that no one
program or agency can do
this alone," said the state-
ment issued by shelter Direc-
tor Sarah Johnson. "No one
program or agency can pro-
vide safety 100 percent of
the time, 24 hours a day,

seven days a week. We ask
for the support and commit-
ment of all community mem-
bers to end violence against
all women and children, as
well as men who are victims
of domestic and sexual
violence."

and applicable definitions to reflect current language; modify eligi-
bility requirements for multiple groups by removing resource re-
quirements for modified adjusted gross income eligibility groups
and reference to aid to families with dependent children income re-
quirements; and modify residency requirements for certain program
eligibility.
