SIOUX FALLS (AP) — A Sioux Falls man is accused of breaking into a shelter for domestic abuse victims and raping a woman while her child slept nearby.

Authorities allege that Heath Big Eagle, 47, entered the woman's room at the shelter through an unlocked window between 3 a.m. and 4 a.m. Monday, forced the woman to take methamphetamine and sexually assaulted

The Associated Press does not identify victims of sex crimes.

Big Eagle faces second-degree rape and first-degree burglary charges, along with violating a protection order. Judge John Hinrichs set bond at \$50,000 cash during Big Eagle's initial court appearance on Tuesday. Big Eagle did not immediately enter pleas. He could face up to 75 years in prison if convicted.
