**Mayfield Earns All-American Honors**  
GULF SHORES, Alabama — Mount Marty freshman Karen Mayfield earned eighth in the marathon, earning All-American honors at the NIAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships on Saturday.  
Mayfield finished the 26.2-mile course in 3:18:48.20. She was the only freshman in the 44-runner field.  
On Friday, MMC junior Abbey VanDenBerg finished ninth in the triple jump with a mark of 37-11 1/2. She was just 1 1/4 inch out of a top-eight spot.  
Freeman native Lillie Koerner helped Dordt to a runner-up finish in the women's 3200 relay (9:04.62).

which players will not be returning next season, but Harris said Smith's message to him was simple.  
"He said that he needed a point guard that was fast and could be a leader," Harris said.  
From there, Harris spoke with his family and committed over the phone to USD assistant Eric Peterson on Saturday night.  
Harris said he had also been in contact with Texas-Arlington, Louisiana-Lafayette and Maine.  
"It was tough. I wanted to make sure I was making the right decision, for my family and myself," he said. "I

wanted to put myself in a position to win."  
Harris spent his freshman season at Division I Fairleigh Dickinson, and averaged 16.9 minutes in 22 games. He then transferred to South Plains College, located in Levelland, Texas.  
In one year with South Plains, Harris helped lead the Texans to a 29-6 record and an NCAA Elite Eight appearance. He played in all 35 games, averaging 6.7 points, 4.8 assists and 3.2 rebounds.  
Harris isn't the only South Plains player to land with a D-I school. Head coach Steve Green also sent players to Ole Miss, Hofstra, Tennessee Tech and Wright State.  
Asked about his familiarity with the Summit League, Harris referenced former South Dakota State standout Nate Wolters, who is now with the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks.  
"It's a quiet conference, but it's very tough," Harris said. "Every team is really solid. You never know what team is going to step up and win it."  
Of his new school, Harris said Smith is trying to "bring a new culture to the program."  
Part of that new culture could be a new style, Harris said. Smith had previously said he wants to utilize an up-tempo system on both ends of the floor.  
"I like to get the ball in transition, use my speed and athleticism to my advantage," Harris said. "I like to get to every spot on the floor, and make my presence felt."
