Officer: Shooting At Muhammad **Cartoon Contest Held In Texas**

GARLAND, Texas (AP) — A provocative contest for cartoon depictions of the Prophet Muhammad in a Dallas suburb was put on lockdown Sunday night and attendees were being evacuated after authorities reported a shooting outside the building.

An officer dressed in SWAT gear took the stage toward the end of the event at the Curtis Culwell Center in Garland and told attendees, including an Associated Press reporter, that a shooting had occurred. He said one officer and two suspects were shot.

It wasn't immediately clear if the shooting was related to the event

Garland Police Department spokesman Joe Harn declined to confirm the SWAT officer's statements and said he had no details.

The Dallas Morning News reported nearby businesses, including a Wal-Mart and Sam's Club, were evacuated.

About 75 attendees were taken to another room, Later, a group of 48 people were escorted to a school bus. Authorities told attendees they would be taken to a nearby high school. A second group was set to be moved shortly after.

Johnny Roby of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was attending the conference. He told the AF he was outside the building when he heard around about 20 shots that appeared to be coming from the direction of a car passing by.

Commissioner Deb Bodenstedt said during the April 7 meeting of the County Commission that Yankton County is not a part of the Napa-Platte authority.

The current Napa-Platte Rail Authority includes only Bon Homme and Charles Mix (counties)," Bodenstedt said. "There is no record of Yankton County being part of the railroad authority, per the Secretary of State's office.'

However, former commissioner and Napa-Platte board member Garry Moore told the Press & Dakotan that Yankton County joined the board in

"They still do have jurisdiction and authority from Platte to the Napa Junction," Moore said. "The issue, when I came on board in 2011, was, 'What happens here? We don't have any people on this Platte-Napa Regional Rail Authority. If something's going to happen in Yankton County, we ought to be able to be a part of it. And that's when we joined the Platte-Napa Regional Rail Authority in 2012.

Currently, the authority is only listed as consisting of Charles Mix and Bon Homme counties. Bruce Lindholm of the South Dakota Department of Transportation also told the Press & Dakotan that Yankton County is not on record as being a part of any regional rail authorities.

The Platte-Napa authority was created in the early 1980s and originally consisted of Charles Mix and Bon Homme counties. Moore said Yankton initially turned down an offer

"But we will never forget vour excitement and ours as were entered the camp and were overwhelmed by you, as you hugged us and brought out a hand-sewn American flag which you had hidden for the occasion," said Lukens, who later became a U.S. diplomat.

Alongside the joy, he remembered that "SS snipers, after hanging out white surrender flags, shot several American GIs as we entered the camp.

Former prisoner Jean Samuel remembered Dachau's liberation as "the most beautiful day of my life." He described inmates from many nations welcoming the American liberators at the camp's assembly ground. "An immense crowd ac-

claimed them, and by some sort of magic the flags of all the countries fluttered in the wind," Samuel said. He recalled that, after showering and being de-loused, "I felt like a living being again. Returning to France at age

21, Samuel said he wanted to forget his experience and get on with his life. "I put Dachau in a corner of my memory," he said. After retiring, however,

he decided to speak out as "a

witness of the unspeakable" and fulfill a duty to keep the memories of what happened at Dachau alive.

That duty has been underlined by the still-unsolved theft of the wrought-iron camp gate bearing the slogan "Arbeit macht frei," or "Work sets you free." A replica was put in place on Wednesday, the anniversary of the camp's liberation, ahead of the commemoration traditionally held on the Sunday following April 29.

"Incidents such as the theft last November of the former gate at the Dachau concentration camp — the central symbol of the prisoners' suffering — unfortunately dismay us time and again," Merkel said. "Incidents like this show clearly how important it is to work every day for a better future, in awareness of Germany's everlasting responsibility for the horrors of the past.

"We will not forget," she said. "We will remember, for the sake of the victims, for our sake and for the sake of future generations.

Merkel thanked survivors for sharing memories of suffering that is "beyond our imagination," which she said help young people today "connect naked numbers and data with faces, names and individual lives." And she stressed the importance of ensuring that today's youth do not turn to extremism.
