The seven signees during the fall signing period included Brett Bye (Vermillion), Anthony Cefolo (Hanover Park, N.J.), Kasey Klapproff (Rapid City), Henry Pohlmeier (Johnston, Iowa), Louie Sanders (Truman, Minn.), Jimsher Sidhu (Surrey, British Columbia) and Cameron Yorcha (Wheaton, Minn.).
