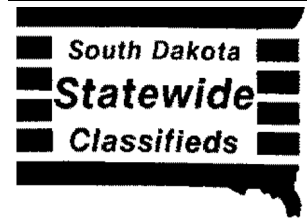

ing birds at the Minnesota State Fair this year to stem the spread of the H5N2 virus. The directive also prohibits exhibitions at county fairs, swap meets, petting zoos and sales.

North Dakota, Pennsylvania and West Virginia had already blocked poultry shows at their state and county fairs. The Ohio State Fair will prohibit poultry from affected states.

to be a major expense and it's a real critical part of our public safety, so we want to make sure — however we proceed — we do it correctly."

According to Nelson, the city is looking to work with G.J. Therkelsen and Associates, Inc., of Chaska, Minnesota, pending approval from the City Commission. She added the study could start at some point early this summer.

Nelson added that this could mean some major upgrade work as well.

"It could end up being a new tower somewhere," she said. "It could be a new tower and working with a provider, or it could be a new tower and working with the state. ... Hopefully that consulting firm will be able to guide us in terms of what their recommendations are for our community and the county."

Payer said, at this point, they're looking to weigh pros and cons of each option.

"Each system has its positives and negatives, and that's kind of where we're at now — weighing out where we need to go due to the differences and what's going to be best for our department."

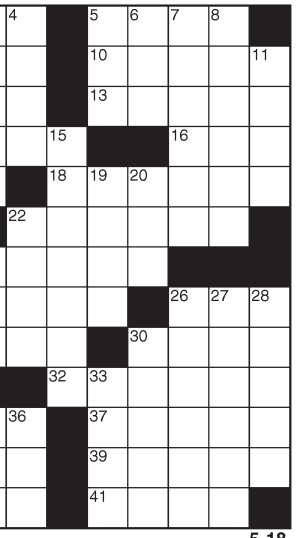
