Viborg-Hurley Election Set For Jan. 10

PARKER — The school board election for the new Viborg-Hurley school district has been set for Jan. 10, according to Turner County Auditor Sheila Hagemann.

Viborg-Hurley candidates could start taking out petitions Monday for the board, she said.

The Turner County auditor's office is overseeing the school board election.

Voters in both the Viborg and Hurley school districts overwhelmingly approved school consolidation in the September elections.

Hurley patrons passed the measure 238-20 for 92 percent approval. Viborg patrons passed it 264-147 for 64 percent approval.

The two school districts will consolidate July 1, 2012. Under the consolidation plan, pre-kindergarten through fourth grade, along with grades 9-12, will attend school in Viborg. Grades 5-8 will attend classes in Hurley.

Hurley currently has 102 students while Viborg has 264 students.

Monday, November 16, 1936

- A number of important personalities, including Mayor W. D. Hayes of Sioux City, are in the city today for a conference at the city hall this afternoon at 2 o'clock, to discuss the feasibility of erecting a dam, or a series of dams, from Yankton up the Missouri river for irrigation and water conservation purposes.
- More than 80 per cent of the homes in the United States are still dependent on ice for refrigeration, Leslie C. Smith, Chicago, told the tri-state association of ice industries at its closing session in Sioux Falls Saturday. He added that more than a million tons of ice were used in 1936 in air conditioning railway passenger cars.

50 YEARS AGO
