'We know that his mind continues to be keen. While he may take more time to express himself orally than was true in the past, he nevertheless is able to do that," Burns said.

At a news conference announcing his candidacy, Rounds said he is running because he wants to end gridlock in Washington and help reduce the federal deficit, set good farm policies and protect industry from undue regulation. He also said he wants to get rid of major parts of President Barack Obama's health care law that expand Medicaid and subsidize insurance for some people because he doesn't think the gov-

ernment can pay for it. Rounds said he learned during his two terms as governor that an elected official can stick to principles, such as controlling government spending, and still get things done.

We need to become a country of cooperation instead of confrontation," he told a crowd of about 100 who showed up for his announcement.

Rounds was a state senator from 1991 to 2001 before serv-
