May we constantly keep ourselves in remembrance of God's Faithfulness and what He expects of us, as we approach the Thanksgiving and Christmas Season.

IF YOU LOOK IN LUKE 16:10-14

Jesus is looking for Faithfulness in His people and He lists 3 specific areas in

Luke 16:10-14. **#1. FAITHFULNESS IN LITTLE THINGS?**

It's obedience in the small things and when others aren't looking that really matter.

#2. FAITHFULNESS IN YOUR FINANCES?

Jesus warned his listeners that they needed to recognize the danger of money becoming their master and God taking second place.

#3. FAITHFULNESS IN ANOTHER MAN'S?

If you are not faithful in another man's, how can God trust you with His and how can He trust you with your own?

NOW WE CAN ALSO SEE HOW THESE QUALITIES WERE DEVELOPED IN THE LIFE OF DAVID AS HE PASSED 4 SPECIFIC CHARACTER TESTS.

TEST #1. BE FAITHFUL IN **NATURAL THINGS.**

Before he was called. anointed and appointed to his God-ordained role as the King of Israel David was faithful as a shepherd boy, tending his father's sheep.

TEST #2 BEING FAITHFUL IN RELATIONSHIPS.

This test was being faithful to the people God had placed in his life which included

those over him and those under him. This test included faithfulness when he was falsely accused, being chased by his King, leading a band of misfits and when things were going well.

TEST #3: BEING FAITHFUL IN LEADERSHIP.

GOD BLESSED DAVID WITH A GREAT TEAM!

He used a band of misfits and then added trained leaders to His team. THEN SOMETHING HAPPENED:

David's enemies, the Amalekites, had raided Ziklag, burned it to the ground and carried off all the women

When David and his men returned to their hometown and saw what had happened they were heart broken and wept until they could weep no more.

Then after their grief subsided, they became angry and bitter. THEY WERE NOW READY

To kill their faithful and beloved

leader YOU MIGHT SAY It was a tough day and a difficult

time to be a leader. But at the end of the day David's faithfulness to follow God and lead brought him and those who

followed him, into a good place.

Operation Christmas Child Set To Ramp Up

With holiday supplies already covering the store shelves, Yankton individuals, families, churches and groups are working to make Christmas a reality for needy kids around the world by filling shoeboxes with toys, school supplies, hygiene items and notes of encouragement. Operation Christmas Child, the world's largest Christmas project of its kind, is ramping up as Yankton residents prepare to collect 1,800 gift-filled shoeboxes during National Collection Week (Nov. 18–25).

At this local collection site in the Yankton area, anyone

can drop off a gift-filled shoe-box to send to a child overseas. Then using whatever means necessary—trucks, trains, boats, bikes and even elephants—the shoebox gifts will be delivered to children worldwide. For many children, the shoebox gift will be the first gift they have ever received.

will often travel thousands of miles, Operation Christmas Child offers a way for participants to follow their box, by using the donation form found at samaritanspurse.org. Donors will receive an email telling the country where their

shoeboxes are delivered. Operation Christmas Child

has collected and delivered more than 100 million shoebox gifts to suffering children in more than 100 countries since 1993. Celebrating its 20th anniversary, Operation Christmas Child hopes to collect another 9.8 million giftfilled shoeboxes in 2013. Operation Christmas Child is a project of Samaritan's Purse, an international Christian relief and evangelism organization headed by Franklin Graham.
