Mead Update

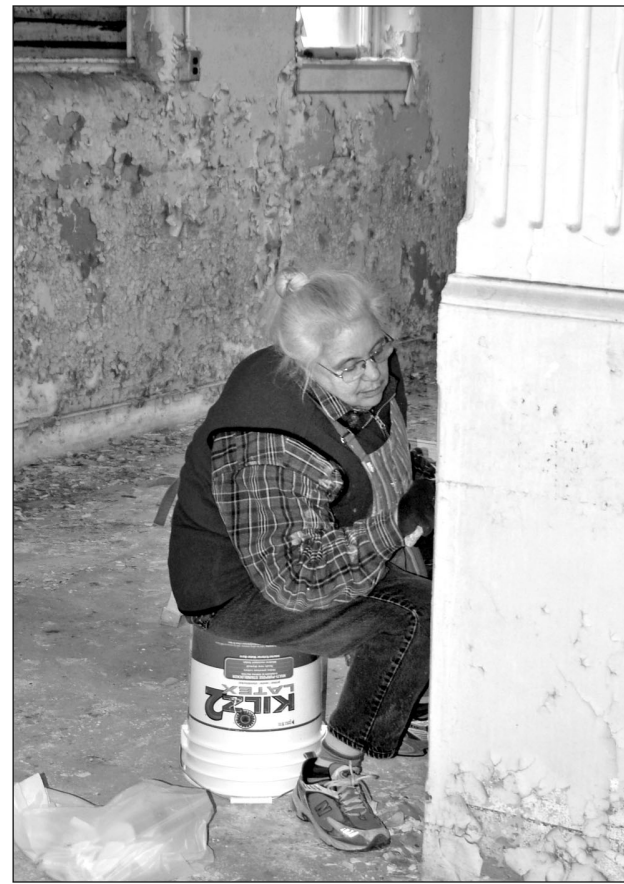
