God's Election Is Perfect

This past Tuesday — Election Day — I voted. I hope that you took the time to cast your vote, too. It is one of the great things about our country's form of government called democracy. It is election by the people, for the people. In other words, we get to elect the leaders for our nation and state.

The only problem is there is no perfect election. In our nation's election, there are winners and there are losers - not every elected official was wanted or elected by everyone. Not everyone I voted for was elected. I am sure that was probably true for you, too. Just because you voted for a certain candidate running for a certain office doesn't mean that the candidate you voted for was elected. It can be sad and disappointing when the candidate you chose did not get elected — or when the candidate you chose does not turn out to



be the type of person you thought you elected.

But that's not the case for God's elect. God's election is a perfect election, not because we are the perfect candidates, but because God chose us by His grace through faith in Christ Jesus. You who believe in

Christ Jesus are God's elect. "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those

whom he justified he also glorified" (Romans 8:28-30 ESV).

Your election is perfect because of the perfect candidate who lived a perfect life free from sin for you, who suffered and died upon a cross for you, and who rose up from the dead for you. He is a candidate who actually sacrificed Himself for the people. Because of His perfect election, He has chosen you for salvation — all you who believe in Him and call on His name. Jesus said, "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide" (John 15:16 ESV).

No matter how Election Day turned out for you and those whom you elected, know that God "desires all people to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4 ESV). Through His Son, Jesus Christ, God has elected you through faith in Him for
