VERMILLION — Alcester-Hudson head coach Brian Haak has been selected as the Region 5 Coach of the Year by the South Dakota Football Coaches Association. The award will be presented at halftime of the Class 11AA state championship football game on Friday in the DakotaDome.

Haak led the Cubs to a 10-1 record and a semifinal berth in the Class 9A playoffs.

Brian Allmendinger (Region 7) of Gregory and Jason Kolousek of Wessington Springs-Woonsocket-Sanborn Central (Region 3) led their teams to the state finals. Their teams will meet in the Class 9AA championship on Thursday afternoon.

Other region honorees include Terry Dosch of Aberdeen Roncalli (Region 1), Steve Gilbertson of Arlington (Region 2), Daniel Maciejczak of Douglas (Region 4), Ryan Evans of McCook Central-Montrose (Region 6) and Clint Nelson of New Underwood (Region 8).
