The Dakota Dance Association Set To Present

'The Nutcracker' Thanksgiving Weekend

ankton's Dakota Dance Association invites you to an enchanting holiday treat for all ages, as it presents its biennial holiday favorite, Tchaikovsky's "The Nutcracker Ballet."

Performances are scheduled for Friday-Sunday, Nov. 28-30, with one performance Friday at 7:30 p.m.; two performances Saturday at 2 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.; and one show on Sunday at 2 p.m. All performances are at the Yankton High School/Summit Activities Center theatre, 1801 Summit Street.

The classic ballet follows Clara (the role shared by Elle Hiltunen and Paige Golden) as she travels through an enchanted dream accompanied by her beloved Nutcracker Prince. Along the way she visits kingdoms of snow, the palace of the Sugar Plum Fairy and encoun-ters entertainers from around the world who give her an evening of fun and fantasy that she will never for-

Acknowledged as one of the most popular ballets of all time, "The Nutcracker" has a rich history. The story first appeared in 1816 in a book of short tales by German writer Ernst Hoffman under the title "Nutcracker and the Mouse King," and it made its ballet debut in 1892 in St Petersburg, Russia.

While its history in Yankton is not quite as long, for more than 30 years the biennial performances have offered the community the opportunity to be entertained and transported to a different time, all while showcasing the talented youth of the area.

"It has been a part of our lives," said choreographer

Dorota Dannenbring. "Every performance is equally special. Every performance has an amazing cast and amazing volunteers. There are so many people who give and don't even care to be recognized. The cast number is more than 150, but the number of parents stepping forward and organizing the small groups and production managers, Mrs. Judy Ryan coordinating with
