Three From SDSU On Awards Finalist Lists
BROOKINGS — Three members of the South Dakota State University football team are finalists for awards to be presented by STATS in conjunction with the Football Championship Subdivision national championship game in January.

Class 9B
Running Back: Lincoln Gibbs, Langford Area. Gibbs was unstoppable his junior season rushing for 2,357 yards and 37 touchdowns. He also had 192 yards receiving and three more scores. He has already racked up 3,680 yards rushing with 53 touchdowns with a full season remaining. "Lincoln had a terrific year. His combination of speed and power makes him an elite back and very difficult to contain," said Lions coach Paul Raasch. "He has put in countless hours in the offseason preparing himself for the year he had."

Defense
Defensive End: Kale Stieg, Hamlin. Opponents soon found out where Stieg was located on the line. Just a junior, he recorded 100 tackles, including 12 for loss and six sacks. He also deflected four passes. He already has 214 tackles, 28 for loss, 17 sacks and an interception with a season remaining. "Kale is a hard-nosed player," said Chargers coach Jeff Sheehan. "He will play wherever you need him and will give you 100 percent effort. He has a great nose for the ball and does all of the little things right."

Defensive Tackle: Dane Dornbusch, Howard. Dornbusch brought traffic to a halt from his spot on the defensive line. The senior had 54 tackles, a sack and a pair of fumble recoveries for the Tigers this fall. The three-year starter finished his career with 145 tackles, three sacks and four fumble recoveries. Dornbusch started as a center and defensive tackle on last year's Class 9A state championship team.

Linebacker: Zach Sebern, Burke-South Central. Sebern led his team with 94 tackles this season (averaging more than 100 per game). He had 10 fumbles for loss, deflected six passes and recovered a fumble. The three-year starter finished his career with 168 tackles, including 14 for loss, three interceptions and four fumble recoveries. "He has great feel and instincts," said Cougars coach Mike Sebern. "We moved him to defensive back in situations."

Defensive Back: Clayton Koch, Harding County. Koch was always around the ball. The senior had 31 solo tackles, 24 assists, picked off 11 passes and deflected 12 others, and also recovered three fumbles. The four-year starter finished with 19 career interceptions. "Clayton was our game-changer on both sides of the football for us this season," said Ranchers coach Jay Wammen. "He played very safely and did an amazing job with his ball skills."

Defensive Back: Reed Harter, Colome. Harter was a force on defense for the Cowboys for the past three years. He capped his senior season with 101 tackles (37 solo and 64 assists) and averaged 10.1 tackles per game. He also picked off three passes. Those numbers pushed his career totals to 277 tackles and 10 interceptions. "He has been a team captain for two years," said Colome coach Scott Kortan, "and the team leader on and off the field for the last two years."

Special Teams
Kicker: Eric Christofferson, Langford Area. Christofferson helped the defense and the offense with his leg this past season. The senior averaged 48.2 yards per kickoff and helped pin opponents deep on their side of the field. He also made 15 extra points and a pair of field goals for the Lions. "Eric was a real weapon for us this season," said Langford Area coach Paul Raasch. "He has a big leg on kickoffs and is quick and accurate on field goals."

Special Teams
Punter: Nathan Hollenbeck, Timber Lake. This senior averaged 38.5 yards per punt and placed five punts inside the 20-yard line for the Panthers. "Nathan had a great leg that had the ability to get the ball very high in the air as well as deep," said Timber Lake coach Jordan Weisbeck. "He also had great accuracy with very few balls being returned at all. He gave our defense a huge advantage in field position throughout the year."

Special Teams
Long Snapper: Christian Schmieders, Dell Rapids St. Mary. Schmieders was a model of consistency when it came to special teams. "He only had one bad snap all year on our punt team and he was the guy we'd release from that position to get downfield and make the tackle," said Cardinals coach Ross Flemmer. Schmieders was a force in all three facets of the game for DRSM. "He excelled on both sides of the ball and special teams," Flemmer said.

Special Team Player: Lathen Stevens, Edgemont. From returning punts and kicks, to longsnapping to making spots on special teams, Stevens made his impact felt for the Moguls. The senior averaged 21.7 yards per punt return, 19.9 yards per kickoff return and scored a touchdown on both. He finished with six career special team TDs. "Teams hardly ever kicked the ball to him, because of his ability to make the big play in the open field," said Edgemont coach Dave Cortney. "On kickoffs and punts he made the tackle or was in on the tackle 77 percent of the time."
