When the Yankton Gazelles step off the court at the South Dakota State Girls' Tennis Tournament today (Saturday) in Sioux Falls, two of the more storied careers in Gazelle history will come to an end.
Both Vanessa Rockne and Lexie Klimisch graduate in May, meaning that they will play their last high school girls' tennis matches. Many of those matches have ended with the Yankton girls winning.
Rockne, who first appeared on varsity as a seventh grader, owns 147 singles victories coming into her flight one singles fifth place match against Sioux Falls Roosevelt's Brittany Kortan. Rockne's total ranks first all-time for Yankton.

Era In Gazelle Tennis Ends Today

Klimisch joined the Gazelles' varsity roster one year later, and sports 122 singles victories as she enters her flight two singles fifth place match against Sioux Falls Washington's Mical Johnson. Klimisch's total also ranks among the tops ever for Gazelles.
The seniors will also pair up for a fifth place match at flight one doubles, facing Eastern South Dakota Conference rival Aberdeen Central.
Both Rockne and Klimisch cemented their places in YHS history with a lot of hard work. Neither has the advantages of many in their sport — no private lessons, no country clubs to play in all season — but both made themselves into very good players with a lot of hard work.
That is a legacy that anyone could be proud of.
