Ground was broken on the bank's current location at 332 Broadway Avenue on March 15, 1984.

Construction commenced the next month, and Valley State Bank opened its doors March 11, 1985. Meanwhile, demolition of the old bank building began on March 9 to make way for the parking lot of the newly-opened Valley State Bank.

On Jan. 19, 1994, Valley State Bank received a national bank charter and changed its name to First National Bank South Dakota. Along with this change came new products and services.

First Bank Card Center moved its operations from the downtown Yankton location to the 2000 block of Broadway Avenue in the spring of 1996.

Finally, First National Bank South Dakota merged with Commercial Bank of Mitchell, Huron and Woonsocket in 1999.

"For the most part, we still do business the way we've always done business," Jones said. "What's changed things is technology and our regulatory environment. We're a highly-regulated industry. It is what it is, and you have to deal with it. I think our ownership in Omaha, which is the largest privately-owned bank in the United States, is committed to communities. We're not branches of First National Omaha. We're separate charters. The expectation is that we'll serve our individual communities like community banks should. Even though we're supported by a fairly large metro organization, community banking is the goal of our ownership."

Joleen Smith, a senior vice president at First National Bank South Dakota in Yankton, said she has seen a lot of changes during her 25 years with the organization. Technology has had the most impact, she stated.

"You talk to the younger employees coming in, and they can't imagine us sitting there with little dividers and separating out checks to fine-sort them down by hand," Smith said.

Customers have embraced changes like online banking and debit cards, she continued.

"People have figured out how to use them for their benefit and move along with the times," Smith said.

Smith stated she has stayed with the bank because of the supportive staff and loyal customers.

During the week-long anniversary celebration, she is looking forward to seeing some old friends.

"We've invited staff who have retired," Smith stated. "I'm excited to see them and show them how banking has changed."

Jones said First National Bank South Dakota will continue to work with other members of Yankton to make the community stronger.

He is particularly proud of the volunteer program at the bank.

"Employees get paid up to two hours a week for doing volunteer things in the community," Jones said. "This year alone, we probably contributed 2,200 hours worth of community involvement. That may be the Sack Pack program, the Banquet, the Boys and Girls Club — there are a variety of things that qualify for volunteering in our organization."

"Our community will get better as long as banks and businesses and our ag community come together and promote Yankton, either through a community foundation, a progressive development group or a strong commitment to agriculture," he continued. "That's the future I see for Yankton and this bank, and that's where we'll focus our energies."

The 50th anniversary celebration will kick off from 9-11 a.m. Monday with cinnamon rolls and coffee. On Tuesday, the bank will hand out candy bars, 20 of which will contain Chamber Dollars. Cupcakes, coffee and punch will be served Wednesday. On Thursday, the bank will award \$25 in Chamber Dollars at the 50-minute mark of every hour beginning at 9:50 a.m. Popcorn, soda and a clown will be on hand from 3-5 p.m. Friday to entertain children. Visitors will also be able to register to win other prizes during the week.
