

Stones Open Paris ‘Warm-Up Gig’ To Fans

PARIS (AP) — The Rolling Stones announced a surprise “warm-up gig” in Paris, and within an hour the Champs Elysees was swarming with fans hoping to get satisfaction with one of the 350 tickets for the Thursday night show.

The (euro) 15 (\$19.5) tickets, announced on the Rolling Stones Twitter account, came with strings attached: No more than two per person, names printed on them and IDs required at the door at the show intended as a prep for the band’s 50th anniversary arena shows in London and Newark, New Jersey.

Guitarist Ronnie Wood had said in an interview with NME this week that the Stones could play several small clubs, possibly under the name the Cockroaches, an alias they’ve used before.

The group has not played together live in five years.

H.W. Brands’ “The Heartbreak of Aaron Burr,” published this year — he’s remembered now as a dark prince of the republic: the adventurer acquitted of treason, the vice president who killed his longtime rival Alexander Hamilton in a duel.

But the Burr portrayed by Larson is a whip-smart manipulator of public opinion, responsible for delivering New York to Jefferson. In an April 1800 state election, he and the Republicans out-organized Hamilton and the Federalists, engaging in the kind of door-to-door, get-out-the-vote effort that has long since become a political commonplace.

Not only that, he was not shy about expressing his ambitions in an age when most candidates, Jefferson and Adams among them, pretended to be above the fray. As a result, Larson writes, “few politicians fully trusted Burr and many actively disliked him — but no one doubted his influence over local politics in New York City, which then dominated that of its state.”

In the end, Burr was not to be trusted, as the election would show. Tied with Jefferson in the electoral vote count, he played both ends against the middle, publicly pledging his support to the party’s presidential candidate while privately giving the impression that “if elected President, he would serve.”

And yet, if this offers another example of his political mutability — “He took ideologically inconsistent stands on various issues,” Larson tells us, “and even courted Federalist support for a possible run ... (for) governor in 1792” — it also suggests just how ahead of his time he truly was. Burr’s politics, after all, are our politics, the politics of expedience, of saying anything to get a vote.

We have to admit that this one caught us by surprise: Not only was the “Revolution” pilot pretty lame, we were convinced that viewers were fed up with fantastical, mythology-laden serials.

But the show has improved and is luring more than 10 million viewers per week (before supplemental DVR numbers). It’s a true success story.

NBC has given full-season orders to “Revolution,” along with a couple of sitcoms, “The New Normal” and “Go On.” Other series aren’t doing quite as well: As previously noted, “Animal Practice” was already put down, and “Guys With Kids” pretty much looks like a dead show walking.

Meanwhile, the Dick Wolf drama “Chicago Fire” is still early in its run, but the outlook isn’t encouraging. “Fire” opened with 6.6 million viewers, then slipped to 5.9 million the next week.

THE CW

Here’s how weird TV is: The aforementioned “Made in Jersey” draws 5.8 million viewers on CBS (in its second week) and is considered a pathetic failure. But the superhero drama “Arrow” pulls in 4 million on The CW and is hailed as a breakout hit.

That’s right, “Arrow” — with hunky star Stephen Amell — drew the biggest debut audience in three years for The CW, where the Nielsen bar isn’t so high. This week, “Arrow” was rewarded with a full-season order.

The CW’s other new dramas — “Beauty and the Beast” and “Emily Owens M.D.” — aren’t quite as lucky. They’ve both generated only so-so ratings thus far, and though the network ordered new scripts this week, we can see the vultures circling.
