Concordia, Morningside Picked To Win GPAC Women's Basketball Title

SILOUX CITY, Iowa — Concordia and Morningside each totaled 93 points and are the preseason coaches' selections to win the 2013-2014 Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC) Women's Basketball Championship, according to the coaches poll released Thursday.

Mount Marty College, which finished 16-14 last season, was tabbed eighth in the preseason poll with 39 points.

The Bulldogs tallied five first place votes, with the Mustangs picked first on four ballots. Morningside was the regular and post-season champion of the league last winter.

Northwestern took the final three place votes and totaled 84 points in being selected third. Briar Cliff was picked fourth and Dakota Wesleyan fifth in the early season poll.

Points were awarded on a 10-1 basis and coaches' could not vote for their own team.

Gun Clause In Vikings Lease Irks Lawmaker

ST. PAUL, Minn. (AP) — A gun clause in the new Minnesota Vikings stadium lease prompted questions Thursday from a state lawmaker and a scramble by the building's landlord to explain the reasons for adding it.

The lease for the planned stadium was adopted last week, but the gun provision didn't receive attention until The Associated Press reported on it this week. At issue is a clause that bars the team and the authority from holding events or using the stadium property "for any gun shop or other store whose primary business is the sale of guns or other weapons." The provision also bars events staged around erotic materials and drug paraphernalia.

Republican Rep. Pat Garofalo of Farmington said in a letter that the restriction could discourage hunting and outdoors groups from scheduling off-season events at the \$975 million stadium, which is being built with a partial public subsidy.

Minnesota Sports Facilities Authority Chairwoman Michele Kelm-Heigen said the intention was to make sure new retail stores within the stadium were gun-free. Hunting expos, where groups and vendors show off the latest gear, would be considered on a case-by-case basis, she said.
