On the main residential campus in Yankton, South Dakota, MMC offers certificate, associate, bachelor's, and master's degrees, and we prepare our students for professional careers in over 30 fields. Located on the bluffs of the Missouri River, the beautiful 80-acre campus has a distinctive mix of modern and historic buildings as well as lush green spaces. In addition, MMC has non-residential locations in Watertown, South Dakota, offering select associate and bachelor's degree programs, and in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, which is home to the nurse anesthesia master's program.

With a total enrollment of

nearly 1,000 students, MMC puts emphasis on maintaining a low student-faculty ratio and small class sizes. Our 12:1 ratio provides an intimate, collaborative environment, so students can learn and grow as individuals. All courses at Mount Marty College are taught by professors, not graduate students. Our student achievement in service learning and clinical and internship experiences, as well as our 96% graduate placement rate, attest to the fact that MMC is on the leading edge of teaching and learning.

We believe that the college experience involves more than just earning a degree. The Yankton MMC campus features a vibrant community where students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of clubs and organizations, campus

### Did You Know?

Six of the 10 college majors with the highest salaries for new graduates have something to do with engineering. So says a survey from the National Association of Colleges and Employers, which notes that computer engineering majors earned the top spot with an average starting salary of \$70,400 for graduates who finished school in 2012. Chemical engineering majors came in second with an average starting salary of \$66,400, while computer science majors, with average starting salaries of \$64,400, came in third. The NACE salary survey relied on information from the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the United States Census Bureau and Job Search Intelligence, a compensation management firm. In addition to computer science, the survey, which examined starting salaries for new graduates in more than 90 fields of study, found that finance, construction science/management and information sciences and systems were the only majors outside the field of engineering to crack the top 10.
