

Attempts Unsuccessful To Save Man

Attempts by local emergency responders to assist an unresponsive male in Yankton's Riverside Park late Sunday were ultimately unsuccessful.
 A report was received at 10:19 p.m. that a 55-year-old male was unconscious with a possible heart attack at the boat dock on the east side of the municipal park.
 The man had been holding a boat in place on the floating dock when his friend noticed he was lying down.
 Two Yankton police officers conducted CPR until a Yankton County ambulance crew arrived on scene. The man was then transported to the hospital.
 However, police say the man did not survive.
 Yankton County Search and Rescue also responded to the incident because the boat the man had been holding in place drifted down the river.

Joint Enforcement Effort A Success

A joint enforcement effort by the Nebraska State Patrol and the South Dakota Highway Patrol led to four arrests and dozens of citations Friday along the Highway 81 corridor in northern Nebraska and southern South Dakota.
 The special enforcement, which began in the morning on Friday, Oct. 25, and continued into the early morning hours on Saturday, Oct. 26, involved troopers from both the Nebraska State Patrol Troop B-Norfolk and South Dakota Highway Patrol District #2-Sioux Falls and focused along the Highway 81 corridor.
 "The fact there were no vehicle fatalities recorded in the enforcement area is a testament to law enforcement and the motorists as well," said Lieutenant Dan Wilson, Troop B-Norfolk. "We want to thank everyone who worked to keep our roadways safe and continue to encourage voluntary compliance with all traffic safety laws."
 The enforcement effort included a night time vehicle check on Highway 81 on both sides of the Discovery Bridge linking Nebraska and South Dakota. A total of 238 vehicles were contacted during a night time vehicle check.
 The following statistics reflect all activity by both the Nebraska State Patrol and the South Dakota Highway Patrol participating in the joint agency enforcement:
 • four driving under the influence arrests;
 • two open container citations and warnings;
 • 79 speeding citations and warnings;
 • 16 seat belt citations and warnings;
 • 12 no operators license citations and warnings;
 • 23 no proof of insurance citations and warnings; and
 • 17 no registration citations and warnings.
