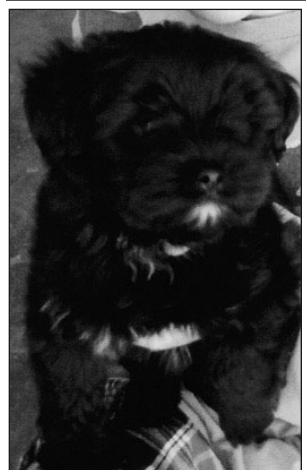

Tree Trimming Required

Under the Ordinance Chapter 24 of the City of Yankton, any tree overhanging any street, sidewalk, alley or right of way within the city shall have the branches trimmed so that the branches do not block or otherwise inhibit street, alley and sidewalk traffic. Trees shall be trimmed in a manner to allow 10 feet of clearance over sidewalks and 12 feet of clearance over streets and alleys. Notice is hereby given to the owners of any premises abutting upon any street, sidewalk, alley or right of way, that all trees or tree branches hanging lower than 10 feet above sidewalks and 12 feet above streets, alleys or right-of-ways are hereby declared a nuisance and the city shall have the authority to trim trees and branches for the purpose of abating the nuisance and assess the costs of the abatement to the property owner by special assessment.

Campaign Signs Don't Belong On Right-of-Way

LINCOLN, Neb. — The Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) is reminding Nebraskans that it is against the law to erect political campaign signs, or any signs, on state highway right-of-way. Various sizes of signs often appear along roadsides around national and local election time.

NDOR maintenance crews will remove signs that are improperly placed within the state highway rights-of-way. These signs will be stored for a brief period of time in NDOR maintenance yards across the state, where they can be reclaimed by the owners.

This state right-of-way reminder applies to any errant plantings or harvesting operations, parked equipment or salvage items, commercial sales, private business stands, garage sale signs and debris.

According to State of Nebraska statutes, no physical or functional encroachments upon right-of-way of State highway are permitted.
